# **Newman Hall - Holy Spirit Parish**

Parish Council Meeting Minutes Monday, March 11, 2024

Homer Teng called the meeting to order at 7:38 PM. Alan Roselius led the group in an opening prayer.

## **Discussion of February Minutes**

- The council came to a consensus that the minutes should not include the names of members who voice private opinions. It is alright to mention the full names of members who make committee reports or motions.
- The council decided to suspend approval of February minutes until edits are made that correspond to the above consensus. Homer will send out the corrected minutes to members, who will approve them via e-mail consensus prior to the next meeting.

## Pastor's Update

- Fr Ivan relayed the news that the Paulist order will be leaving UC Berkeley after 117 years,
  effective June 30, 2024. The main reason for this decision is the shortage of priests in active
  ministry. The order is also leaving another college and closing three of their national
  ministries.
- The order will be releasing a press statement on Wednesday, March 13 to announce these changes. The Diocese of Oakland will issue a press release later the same week.
- Three possible scenarios for the future of Newman Hall-Holy Spirit Parish:
  - o The Bishop of Oakland may appoint a diocesan priest to lead the parish.
  - The bishop may merge the parish with St. Joseph the Worker parish in Berkeley.
  - o The bishop may appoint another religious order to run the parish.
- Fr Ivan suggested different ways of communicating this change to the community. After some discussion, the council agreed to support a video announcement by Fr. Ivan to the parish

community. Several council members volunteered to be in the video as a show of solidarity. The recording is scheduled for Tuesday, March 14 at 11:30 AM in the chapel.

- The council agreed to organize Town Hall meetings after each Mass on April 6 and 7 to allow parishioners to give feedback and receive an update about the upcoming transition.
- For guidelines on handling the present situation, Fr Ivan reviewed the five stages of grief –
  denial, anger, bargaining, depression, and acceptance. He then described an alternative
  model: shock and disbelief, searching and yearning, disorganization & repair, rebuilding &
  healing. A general discussion followed.
- Fr Ivan led the council members to discuss recommendations for the bishop about whom
  would be a good fit for Newman. The council would like to see that a pastor who is good at
  engaging with students. We would also like to have someone who will honor the core values
  of the parish and support the vibrant lay-led ministries that involve parishioners of different
  generations.
- Fr. Ivan's transition plan will include: (i) updating job descriptions of staff roles, (ii) documentation of Newman procedures and policies on administration, ministries, and physical plant, and (iii) cleaning up priority projects. These items will be included in a transition document that will be given to the new pastor.
